# Year 4 Knowledge Organiser- French- Where in the World?

Grammar/Key sentences	
The word <b>allé</b> (went) is called a past participle and it has to agree with the subject. So a boy will write Je suis <b>allé</b> whereas a girl will write Je suis <b>allée</b> .	
Note that <b>en</b> is used to say in before a feminine country but <b>au</b> is used to say in when the country is masculine. If the country is an island like Haïti we say <b>à</b> .	
Où habites-tu? J'habite <b>au/en</b>	Where do you live? I live in
Quelle est la capitale <b>du/de la/de l'...</b> ... est la capitale <b>du/de la/ de l'...</b>	What is the capital of...? ... is the capital of...
De quel continent vient-il/ <b>elle</b> ? Il/ <b>elle</b> vient de...	Which continent does he/she/it come from? He/she/it comes from...
L'Australie est au sud de l'Équateur. La Colombie est sur l'Équateur. L'Angleterre est au nord de l'Équateur.	Australia is south of the Equator. Colombia is on the Equator. England is north of the Equator.
