At Clarendon we want every child to enjoy learning and be happy. Sometimes you may have concerns and it is important that we can help to put it right.

If you have *any* concerns regarding your child here are the ways we can help:

1. Contact your child's teacher – they know your child best and are the first person who can help. You can ring the office and ask for the teacher to ring you or arrange a meeting.
2. Contact the Phase leader – Years 3 and 4 - Miss Hayday /Years 5 and 6 – Mrs Wardle They can help with class/year group issues.
3. Emotional concerns/Wellbeing/Deployment etc – Ask to speak to our Pastoral Lead – Mrs Allen who will then help to signpost you to support.
4. If none of the adults are able to help it would then be passed on to Miss Cornish, Head of School.

As I am sure you are aware, the Government is encouraging good attendance in schools and we support this in a number of ways. However, we appreciate that children are poorly! Please also see advice from the UK Health Agency regarding when you should keep your child off school and for how long. These are the guidelines we follow.





Should I keep my child off school?



Yes

Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

No

but make sure you let their school or nursery know about...

Hand, foot and mouth	Glandular fever
Head lice	Tonsillitis
Threadworms	Slapped cheek
