



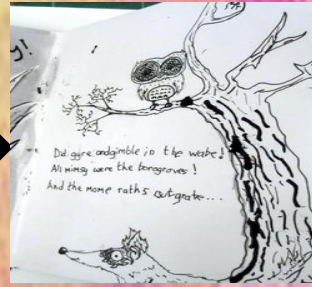
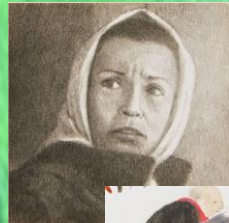

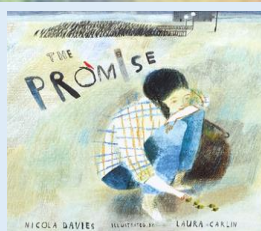

<u>Word</u>	<u>Definition</u>
charcoal	A black stick made from burnt wood that artists use
Composition	Where the text and illustrations will go on your page
Graphic novel	A story told by using illustrations and no text
Illustration	A drawing to tell a story
medium	What the artists uses to mark make
Visual narrative	The story that is told through the illustrations. What do the pictures tell you?

Artist inspiration-

Laura Carlin- an illustrator who uses the writers' text to inspire her illustrations



Shaun Tan – an illustrator who his illustrations for his own stories, the genre of graphic novels.
