



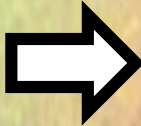
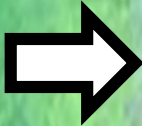

Word	Definition
arrange	The way pieces are placed on the paper
Collage	Using small pieces to make a larger art piece
elements	The parts of your picture
Positive	The part that has been cut out to make the main shape.
Negative	What is left over after the 'main' positive part has been cut out.

**Matisse** – A classical artist who used collage



**Romare Bearden** – A contemporary artist inspired by the works of Matisse.
